Whether travelling to work or to the grocery store, consider your travel options. Right now 35% of greenhouse gases are emitted from vehicles. You can make a difference by trading just one drive-alone trip a week for a TravelSmart trip.

Transit

Transit is reliable and often the fastest way to get around. Take transit and save money with monthly farecards, or register your company with TransLink's Employer Pass Program (EPP). EPP offers a 15% discount on annual transit passes when a company enrolls with 25 or more employees.

Cycling / Walking

Walking and cycling are healthy, inexpensive, and easy on the envi-

ronment. TransLink provides bike access on transit, bike storage, and planning and funding support for bikeways and cycling infrastructure such as the Central Valley Greenway. Find local cycling maps at www.travelsmart.ca.

Ridesharing

Instead of driving alone, fill up your car with people. Ridesharing is a great option for people who share similar schedules. Share the costs by offering a ride in your vehicle, finding a ride in someone else's vehicle, or joining a vanpool at www.ride-share.com.

Teleworking

The best commute is no commute! Ask your employer about telework options at your workplace.

Guaranteed Ride Home

A Guaranteed Ride Home (GRH) provides commuters who regularly ride-share, cycle, walk, or take transit, access to a ride home when an unexpected emergency arises. Encourage your employer to implement a GRH policy.

Carsharing

Have access to a vehicle when you really need one - without the hassle of owning one. Register with the Co-operative Auto Network or Zipcar. Both agencies offer individual and corporate carshare programs.
